



Technology Checklist for New Faculty

This checklist is intended to assist you in your transition to Gabelli School of Business at Fordham University. It will help you get started with the technology resources that are available at the University and the Business School.

AccessIT ID and Password

AccessIT ID and password allows you to log in to university email and a variety of web applications and systems. To claim your ID, visit <https://claim.fordham.edu> and follow the onscreen instructions. For help, call IT Customer Care (ITCC) at 718-817-3999.

Multi-Factor Authentication (MFA)

MFA provides an additional layer of security to your login credentials by adding a personal device of yours, such as your mobile phone, as the third authentication instrument. Wi-Fi Connection

From your computer or device, connect to **Connect-Fordham-WiFi** connection. Follow the on-screen instructions and provide your AccessIT ID and password to connect as a *faculty*. You may also choose to connect as a *guest* without providing your authentication credentials at the expense of access to your Fordham network drive.
